For other families, the school is yet to develop a dialogue and this is something they would like to do, to ensure they have a full understanding of the barriers faced so that they are able to work in partnership with you to improve attendance.

Team EWS will be working in school with us every Friday and will be in contact with identified families to offer guidance and support. I hope you will all see this as a supportive measure and one to ensure your child is in school as much as possible so they achieve success in their education.
